Hopefully, the renovations to the 428 building will be completed by then. We are trying to get thirty years worth of "stuff" moved over there. I'm chipping away at it daily, and thankfully our wonderful Mount Hope Interns are helping tremendously.

Robert Glennon is a huge help as our new executive director, handling more details than I could process in a decade! Now that I am a full time missionary, I could never handle all the details alone—especially with bishop duties, district duties, and my already half-insane travel schedule. My son once told me, "Robert is a get-it-done guy."

Will you pray with Mary Jo and me? Pray that we will have enough undesigned donations to cover the building renovations, and that we'll get plenty of volunteers to help us with the work of SGM so we can be fully launched and engaged in accelerating the Gospel of Jesus Christ at a new breakneck speed!

Two Sectors Of People

It was nearly two decades ago when the Lord spoke to my heart one morning about two sectors of people that were strongly on HIS HEART. The first category was pastors and ministerial trainees. The second group was “at risk” children, particularly those growing up in housing developments and inner cities.

I realized by assisting pastors and ministerial trainees with scholarships and specialized training (like we provide at the Church Planter’s School and Pastors’ School) we could literally reach hundreds of thousands of souls through them...no matter what country they were in.

After working several times with Tommy and Matthew Barnett at the Los Angeles Dream Center, I understood why inner city kids were on God’s heart. Some were living in cardboard boxes on the streets. Others might have had homes, but no wholesome influence in their lives. Gangs, drug dealers, and cult religions were preying on them. Some were being taken against their will into human trafficking, sex slavery, and child pornography.



I visited the dorm where 60 girls lived and were being made into disciples of Jesus. Pastor Matthew and his team rescued these young girls off the streets—girls who had been forced (or deceived) into prostitution.

Stop Her Nightmare

“A young girl shivers in her room as she hears someone negotiating with a man in the hall outside her door. She knows what is coming, and is powerless to stop it. Somewhere, deep inside, she knows life is supposed to be different, but there is no way out. No escape. She curls up into a little ball on the corner of her bed, and stares at the doorknob, waiting for it to turn and the nightmare to begin again.”

Your partnership with SGM *is helping to stop her nightmare* through our grants to ministries like LA Dream Center, Metro-Kidz Ministry, and scholarships for these kids to be rescued, saved, and trained for Christ.

2. Grants for inner city ministries who are reaching “at risk” children.
